Patent Rights are exclusive rights given to the patent holder protecting his/her invention in the borders of a particular country where the patent is applied. Internationally there are no common laws. But UN has Laws to protect the rights of the inventor by giving a chance to the holder for applying in multiple countries at the same time, wherever the patent holder desires to apply. 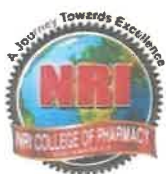
